Nørhalne Cup 2019

- **Takes place for the 36th time during the Ascension Day Holiday in 2019 – from May 30th until June 1th.**
- **3 days packed with football – 7 matches for each team, with final group matches, play-offs and finals.**
- **Tournament for both girls' teams and boys' teams – with international participation in all groups.**
- **Tournament with full board – up to 10 meals.**
- **42 groups to compete in – Elite level and with other age groups divided into A and B levels.**
- **Qualified and certified referees in all groups and levels.**
- **Tournament played on excellent grass pitches and new synthetic pitches.**
- **Reasonable price and overnight accommodation in school classroom as standard.**
- **Special offers on upgrade to holiday resorts, hotel or youth hostels.**
- **Free tournament bus transport from school accommodation to match ground – 15-minute intervals.**
- **Personal gifts for all players - a Nørhalne Cup towel.**
- **Attractive trophies for winners and runners-up with gold, silver and bronze medals for players and coaches. For all teams there will be a crystal year trophy.**
- **The tournament welcomes around 500 teams from all over Europe – normally 15-18 nations in the tournament.**

Nørhalne Cup also makes an ideal club tournament, since we have classes suitable for a number of different teams in the club.

Arrival and departure

Teams can arrive from 17.00 on Wednesday May 29th, with latest departure at 10.00 on Sunday June 1th. We play football from Thursday morning to Saturday afternoon. At Nørhalne Cup, the focus is on football and the chance to play matches against teams from other countries. All teams are guaranteed at least 7 matches on attractive grass pitches. Nørhalne Cup are played in 5-8 and 11 a side in options for all teams and countries.

PRICES

Team fee

5-a-side: a fee of 160 Euro per team covers participation in the tournament. 8-a-side and 11-a-side: a fee of 222 Euro per team covers participation in the tournament.

Participation Card A

110 Euro per person.

Participation in the tournament, full board from breakfast on Thursday until breakfast on Sunday, school accommodation, personal gift for all players, trophy for all teams, free tournament bus transport.

Participation Card B

135 Euro per person. Same as Card A + prepaid admission to Faarup Sommerland (bus transport not included).

Participation Card E

121 Euro per person – Elite tournament.

Accommodation

Accommodation is at schools in the region. We try to ensure that your matches are played on pitches close to the school at which your team is accommodated. All participants must bring their own single airbed and sleeping bag. Breakfast and evening meals served at the schools, whilst a sandwich is available at lunch-time at the stadium at which the team concerned is playing. All accommodation at Nørhalne Cup, must be arranged in collaboration with us.

Hotel / Holiday resort

If players, coaches and other officials wish to enjoy accommodation at a hotel or holiday resort, Youth Hostels, there are several options available. Accommodation

at a holiday resort is available including full board and participation Card A at a rate of 218 Euro for a stay of 3 nights or 238 Euro for 4 nights. Hotel or other accommodation – prices on request. Parents are also welcome to stay. We have good deals available to accompanying parents and supporters, either at holiday resorts or hotels close to the match venues.

For elite teams

Nørhalne Cup is also an elite Tournament, which is designed to attract many of the best youth teams in Europe. This is the 16th year of the tournament. It has expanded over the years to encompass 8 Elite boys classes, and is a popular tournament for many professional clubs from a wide range of countries. has developed Nørhalne Cup into a tournament that many clubs attend year after year because the football itself is the first priority. Nørhalne is a small village of 1700 inhabitants situated 15 km north of Aalborg. All the matches at Nørhalne Cup are played on 75 good quality 11-a-side, 8-a-side and 5-a-side pitches at various venues throughout the region. All matches are played on attractive pitches and all the local clubs have a clubhouse and good facilities.



Camping

Parents or supporters may stay in their own tent or caravan next to the schools of accommodation. This costs 67 Euro per tent or caravan incl. electricity and access to showers and toilets. Parents and other family members can purchase a wristband that entitles them to meals at the schools.

Faarup Sommerland

All participants have the chance to visit Faarup Sommerland, which is located 20 km from Nørhalne and is one of Denmark's best amusement parks, offering a huge range of different activities. Once admission has been paid, all the rides and attractions in the park are free. Alternatively, you can play Football Golf on an attractive 18-hole course in Nørhalne – please contact us to book a round and transport, if

Bus transport

Nørhalne Cup has its own bus routes between all schools and match venues. Buses run every 15 minutes and the service is free for all participants. Age dispensation

Age dispensations may be granted to a maximum of 3 players (11-a-side) or 2 players (5-a-side and 8-a-side) born after 1st July in the year prior to the relevant age group. Applications for dispensation, can be made on our website, www.norhalne-cup.dk. We publish the names of all players, that have been granted dispensation on our website and check ages of all players prior to the first match of the tournament by means of passport or another form of identification.

Referees

Only qualified referees that are currently active are eligible to referee at Nørhalne Cup. Nørhalne Cup 2018 was officiated at by referees from 13 different countries, which also helps to give our tournament an international flavour.
